## PRESS RELEASE: COVID-19 Vaccine UPDATE 1/27/2021

## Vaccine Allocation:

Idaho: <21,000 / week</li>

• Panhandle Health District (5 Northern Counties): 2,800 / week

Bonner General Health: 200 / week

Bonner General Health will be expanding our vaccine clinic to the following hours:

Monday – Friday, 9:00 AM – 3:00 PM, by appointment only.

We have over 4,400 people on our vaccine registration list. Three thousand of those are in our >65 years category. At this time, we have updated our registration form to accommodate the following categories **based on current supply allocation**:

- 1a. Healthcare Personnel
- 1a. Long-term Care Staff
- 1a. Long-term Care Resident
- 1a. Home care provider for >65 or adult/child with a high-risk medical condition
- 1a. EMS
- 1a. Dental Provider/Staff
- 1a. Pharmacist/Pharmacy Staff
- 1b. First Responder (firefighter/police)
- 1b. Safety (productive services /community support)
- 1b. Education Pre-K-12 Staff
- 1b. Daycare/Childcare Staff
- 1b. Correctional & Detention Facility

\*We will not be accepting any new >65 years registrations until we have made it partially through the 3,000+ we already have in our system.

\*Please note this is not an issue of staffing at Bonner General Health. This is an issue of national supply allocation of the vaccine. As soon as we receive more vaccine allocation, we will re-open registration for the 65+ category and additional 1b categories.

If you have filled out the registration form on our website, we have received your request, and you are on our list of people to call. We will give priority to the above categories. With the volume of submissions, please be patient as we work our way through the list.

To date, end of day January 26, 2021, Bonner General Health has vaccinated 1300 people; 172 of those were second doses.

Our goal, as always, is to serve our community by providing excellent healthcare close to home. We will work through this list as quickly and safely as possible. Again, our ability to continue with vaccines depends on our allocation of vaccines. Thank you for your patience and support as we work through this ever-evolving situation.
