We also have an immediate need for ¼” to ½” elastic. If you have a stash, please consider donating it to this cause. Elastic is the new TP and we are in dire need! We are good on fabric and other supplies thanks to a monetary contribution from the Sandpoint Rotary Club and others who have cleaned out their personal sewing collections for this effort.
